

> Nations of the last 200 years




Colonization- to inhabit Colonialism- the establishment, exploitation, maintenance, acquisition, & expansion of colonies in one territory by people from another territory.

## Slavery

- Slavery involuntary servitude (aka working without getting paid)
- Slavery was practiced among many of the African kingdoms for thousands of years
- When European colonization began, the colonial powers needed a work force (which they found in Africa)
- Most slaves were captured and sold by other African slave traders (but the Europeans were of course willing buyers)




# Infant Mortality Rate (deaths per 1000 live births)


# GDP (in billions)-Value of all goods & services produced in a country within a year

#### **GDP** (in billions)




Per Capita Income (in thousands) ----Average yearly income per person

HIV – a virus that invades the immune system and causes AIDS


 AIDS – when the HIV virus begins actively attacking the immune system.


#### A global view of HIV infection 39.5 million people [34.1-47.1] living with HIV in 2006


