PROS & CONS OF HAVING OIL


• <u>Pros</u>

Nations Producing More than One MILLION Barrels of Oil per Day







- <u>Supply</u>
 - No one knows for sure how long the oil will last.
 - More supply = lower prices, Less supply = higher prices
- Demand
 - As countries become more industrialized & developed, they need more oil & petroleum products.
 - More demand = higher prices, Less demand = lower prices
- Political Unrest
 - Turmoil in Middle East = (???) oil prices




